



ROCHEDALE SOUTH STATE SCHOOL JUNIOR SOCCER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM



At Rosedale South State School students have the opportunity to participate in a Junior Soccer Development Program. The program is run during play breaks by Mr. Stilianos and is open to Year 3s in Term 3, and to Year 4s in Term 4. The focus is fun, participation and a development of skills. Through game-based sessions, students develop an understanding of the game, rules and positions, readying our students for Interschool Sport Competition in Years 5 and 6 in our RSSS Soccer Teams. Students who show excellent skills, effort and participation in the Junior Development Program have the chance to be identified and selected a year earlier as Year 4s in our Junior School Soccer Team.

Rosedale South State School is equipped with excellent facilities and space for nurturing Soccer skills and game play with three junior sized Soccer fields on our school campus for student use during play breaks and for training. A field on our top oval caters for our Year 3s and 4s, while two junior sized fields with goals and nets facilitate our Year 5 and 6 students on our bottom oval.

Rosedale South State School is also in partnership with Slacks Creek Football Club who allow us to use two full sized Soccer fields with goals, nets, line markings and club facilities for use as our home field venue for the Friday Interschool Sport Season in the Logan District Competition.

Since the beginning of our Junior Soccer Development Program in 2015, RSSS Soccer Teams have won five District Premierships and made three Metropolitan East Regional Soccer Grand Finals.
