ROCHEDALE SOUTH STATE SCHOOL STUDENT DRESS CODE

The values of care, courtesy, cooperation, commitment and contribution underpin all that

we do at Rochedale South State School. Therefore taking care of ourselves and showing pride in our appearance and in our school is important. The wearing of our school uniform is compulsory as ratified by our school community.

The P & C of Rochedale South State School resolves that it supports the Student Dress Code for Rochedale South State School because it believes that the Student Dress Code promotes the objectives of Education (General Provisions) Bill 2006.

In particular, the P & C supports the intention of a student dress code in providing a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment by:

- ready identification of students and non-students at school;
- eliminating distraction of competition in dress and fashion at school:
- fostering a sense of belonging; and
- developing mutual respect among students through minimising visible evidence of economic or social differences.

A. CLOTHING

PREP (Boys & Girls)

Tri-colour school sports polo shirt and bottle green shorts

PRIMARY

Boys

Day Uniform

Green shorts, blue and green checked shirt with an embroidered pocket.

Sports Uniform

Tri colour top, green sports shorts, white socks.

Girls

Day Uniform

Blue and green checked blouse or shirt, embroidered pocket, green culottes/skort.

Sports Uniform

Tri colour top, green sports shorts or green culottes/skort – to be ordered from the uniform shop.

Seniors

Bottle green trousers or a bottle green knee-length pleated skirt may be worn by all seniors (years 5-6) in place of the shorts or skort.

N.B. It is compulsory at formal functions for the School Captains to wear the school bottle green trousers and/or pleated skirt which are to be purchased by the students from the school uniform shop.

ALL STUDENTS

- House shirt (red, green or blue collared polo shirt) for house competition days
- School bucket hat (green)
- Winter Uniform (as above plus) green track pants / plain navy blue fleecy zip jacket or pullover (sew-on badges available from Uniform Shop) / bottle green or navy blue plain or ribbed tights may also be worn under shorts.
- * Dress uniform (checked shirt) is to be worn on assembly days (unless class is Prep) and for special events/excursions.

In accordance with the school's Sun Safe Policy all students must wear their school bucket hat for all outside activities. Caps are not accepted. *No hat, no play.*

C. FOOTWEAR

Black waterproof leather or synthetic leather shoes with white socks must be worn. Canvas shoes are not acceptable. (See example over page). In the interests of safety, all students, including Prep, must wear closed in shoes and socks. No sandals or thongs are permitted.

D. PERSONAL PRESENTATION

- Hair should be neat and tidy and not hanging in the eyes.
 Hair should be tied back if shoulder length or longer.
 Unnatural hair colours or extreme hair styles (including but not limited to spikes, tracks, shaved letters or symbols) are not permitted.
- All hair accessories (including scarves worn for religious reasons) need to be in the school colours of navy blue, bottle green or white.
- Jewellery: One watch / one flat ring only / one pair of studs or sleepers (other face/body piercing is inappropriate) / necklaces or bangles are not to be worn (except for medialert and those of religious significance, correspondence from parents is required annually for the student to wear jewellery with religious significance).
- Make up and coloured nail polish is not permitted for school.

E. CONSEQUENCES FOR NON COMPLIANCE WITH STUDENT DRESS CODE

If a student does not attend school or school related activities in the correct uniform the following actions may be taken:

- The student may be offered appropriate items from the bank of spare uniforms held at the school for this purpose.
- The student may be prevented from attending, or participating in, any activity (that is not an essential educational program) for which the student is representing the school.
- 3. Parents informed via an Infringement Slip and support requested to prevent recurrence.
- 4. Removal of inappropriate items/adornments e.g. jewellery or makeup.
- Persistent refusal to follow instructions regarding compliance with the Dress Code may result in a consequence consistent with the Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students.

The only **exemptions** to this policy are students whose impairments prevent their ability to conform to the dress code or students whose families have religious or cultural grounds for conscientious objection. In such cases, these students will need to discuss their situation with school administration who will review the issues involved.

Uniform Shop Opening Hours:

Tuesday 7.45am – 10.15am or by appointment.

Wearing the school uniform is compulsory at Rochedale South State School. The school's Uniform Shop supplies new and second hand (when available) uniforms for purchase by families. An order form is available on the school website and can be left with the tuckshop convenor. Direct ordering can be conducted through the school tuckshop. This is a service provided by the P&C to keep the cost of the uniform down.
