Metro South Health is investing in Oral Health Services for the Logan community with the expansion of the oral health clinic at the Logan Central Community Health Centre.

Eligible adults and children can access a range of high-quality dental services such as examinations, x-rays, cleaning, fissure sealing, fillings, root canals and extractions.

### Who is eligible?

Adults are eligible for free public dental care if they hold a Medicare Card **and** one of the following:

- » Pensioner Concession Card (issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs or Centrelink)
- » Health Care Card
- » Commonwealth Seniors Health Card
- » Queensland Seniors Card.

Children are eligible for free public dental care if they hold a Medicare Card **and** are one of the following:

- » aged 4 years through to Year 10
- » students in Years 11 or 12 who have a current Centrelink, Health Care or Pension Card
- » aged 0–3 years whose parents have a current Centrelink, Health Care or Pension Card.

We also provide free public dental care for children 2–17 years who are eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS).
